MEMORANDUM OPINION

Opinion by Justice [LANG-MIERS](#).

*1 Relators contend the trial court erred in over-
ruling their objections and granting plaintiffs' motion
to compel interrogatories because it failed to give
them the full time to object and respond to the inter-
rogatories and it ordered discovery that is overbroad
and burdensome. Based on the record before us, rela-
tors have not shown that they sought relief from the
trial court regarding its failure to give them sufficient
time to object and respond to the interrogatories. Ad-
ditionally, the relators have not shown that they are
entitled to the relief requested. See [TEX.R.APP. P.
52.8\(a\)](#); [Walker v. Packer](#), 827 S.W.2d 833, 839-44
(Tex.1992) (orig.proceeding). Accordingly, we
DENY relators' petition for writ of mandamus.
